PARABLE OF THE UNMERCIFUL SERVANT – MATTHEW 18:21-35

St. Catherine of Siena said this — “the reason God gave us other people was so that we can learn to love like God loves.” See if it was just us and God, we would be loving the one who was all perfect and all good, and who never did any harm to us. But that's not how God loves. He doesn't just love those who are good, he loves those who are wicked, he loves those who hate him, he loves those who sin against him. So, in order for our love to not be love of ones who do good to us, but to love our enemy as well, he gives us our neighbors. He surround us with people who are full of faults and sins and annoyances, and who get on our nerves, and who hurt us and harm us, in order to teach us to love a truly divine love, which is not just love of those who love us, but love of those who hate us, because that's how God is. He loves even those who hate him. He loves his enemies and not just friends. That's the point from St. Catherine of Siena.
