COVID-19 Update

Bishop Strickland issued the following update August 6:

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has issued updated guidance regarding the use of masks for protection against the spread of COVID-19. Specifically, to maximize protection from the Delta variant and prevent possibly spreading it to others, the CDC is recommending that individuals wear a mask indoors in public if they are in an area of substantial or high transmission.

For liturgies and activities at parishes in the Diocese of Tyler, pastors and parishioners should be aware of this guidance and apply it to their individual, family, and community circumstances as appropriate in order to keep everyone healthy.

Actualización de COVID-19: agosto de 2021

El obispo Strickland emitió la siguiente actualización el 6 de agosto:

Los Centros para el Control y la Prevención de Enfermedades (CDC) han publicado una guía actualizada sobre el uso de máscaras para la protección contra la propagación de COVID-19. Específicamente, para maximizar la protección de la variante Delta y evitar la posibilidad de propagarla a otras personas, los CDC recomiendan que las personas usen una máscara en el interior del público si se encuentran en un área de transmisión considerable o alta.

Para las liturgias y actividades en las parroquias de la Diócesis de Tyler, los párrocos y feligreses deben conocer esta guía y aplicarla a sus circunstancias individuales, familiares y comunitarias, según corresponda, para mantener a todos seguros y saludables.
