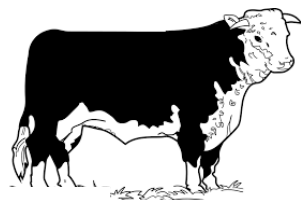
Prevent Abuse

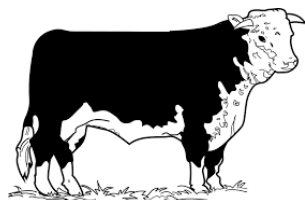
